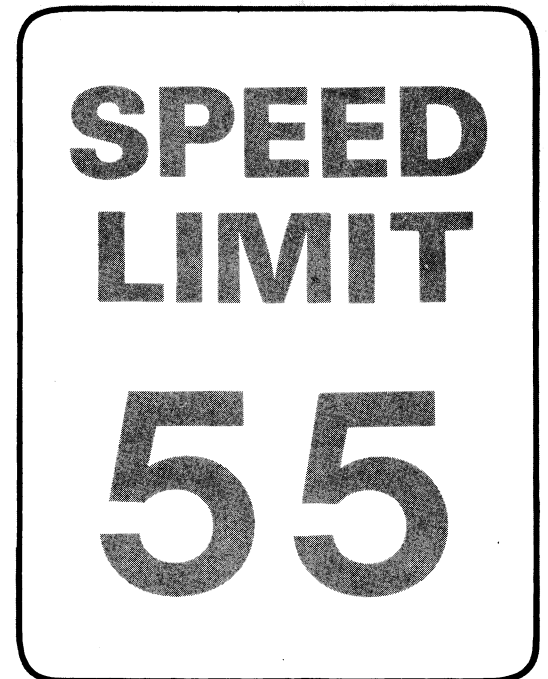

Statistics indicate that the death rate for that period was 2.02 traffic fatalities for every 100 million miles traveled. This ratio is the lowest in the country and is a direct result of the cooperation of all those who use the roadways of our State. We must, however, continue to make every effort to reduce traffic fatalities even further through strict compliance with the 55 mph federal speed limit as well as the traffic laws of our State.

Hopefully, the continued efforts and cooperation of the public and federal, state and municipal agencies will help us attain an even more desirable traffic safety record in future years.

The following pages contain statistics relating to fatal traffic accident records for New Jersey, which were compiled by the Fatal Accident Unit of the Division of State Police for the year 1976.

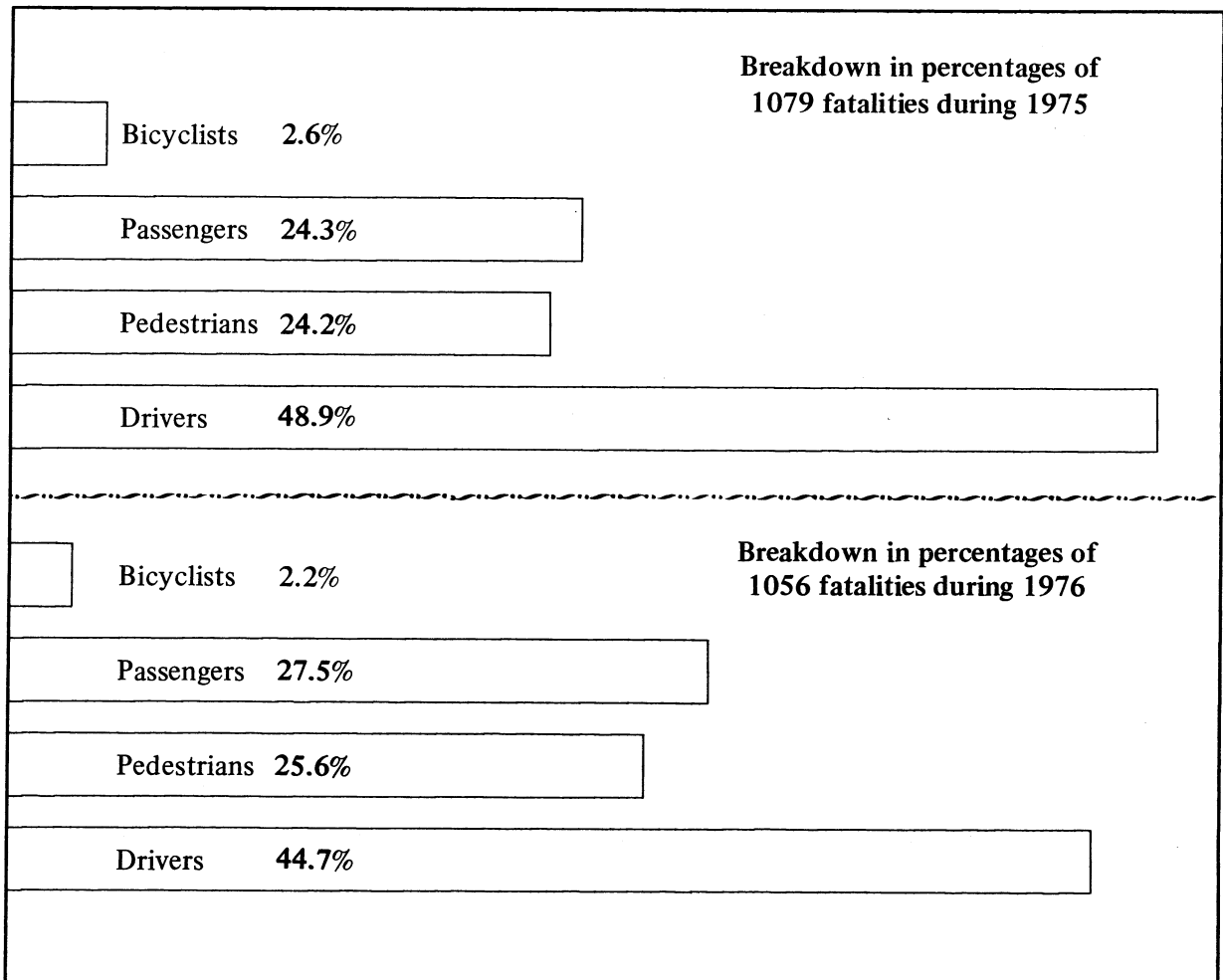

M. ALCOHOL FACTOR

There were 1056 Fatalities during 1976. Of this total, 735 were tested for alcohol and 321 were not tested. The various reasons for those not tested were: delayed deaths; age factors; contamination of samples, and the failure on the part of some investigative agencies and medical examiners to cause tests to be performed on victims. Of the Fatalities, 472 were drivers; 290 passengers; 270 pedestrians and 24 bicyclists. Of the 735 tested, 390 were positive for alcohol in varying degrees and 345 were negative. This would indicate 53.1% of the Fatalities tested were positive for alcohol and 46.9% were negative.

The attached chart is a breakdown of victims and the percentage of alcohol in each classification. An analysis of the chart by victim classification indicates the following:

1. Drivers:

There was a total of 472 drivers killed, of which 382 were tested. Of those tested, 216 were positive and 166 were negative, for a 56.5% alcohol factor. The .15% and over period alcohol level, has the largest number listed. Of the 216 imbibing drivers, 152 or 70.4% had an alcohol level of .10% or higher.

2. Passengers:

There was a total of 290 passengers killed, of which 164 were tested. Of those tested, 91 were positive and 73 were negative for a 55.5% positive alcohol factor.

3. Pedestrians:

There was a total of 270 pedestrians killed, of which 179 were tested. Of those tested, 81 were positive and 98 negative for a 45.3% alcohol factor.

4. Bicyclists:

There was a total of 24 bicyclists killed. Ten (10) bicyclists were tested for alcohol content. Of those tested, 2 were positive and 8 negative for a 20.0% alcohol factor.

SPECIFIC AREAS OF CONCERN

INTERSTATE HIGHWAY FATALITIES

The Interstate Highway System of New Jersey is now approximately 78.4% completed. Of the 416.8 miles of roadway which are projected for this system, 326.76 miles have been opened to the motoring public. With this number of roadway miles open through a variety of areas such as rural, urban, flat, hilly, etc., an equal variety of accidents have become prevalent. Beyond the smaller "damage to property" type of accidents we are now encountering the non-repairable . . . the human fatality. Thirty percent of the thirty-three (33) fatal accidents which occurred during 1976 involved pedestrians. Thirty-seven percent of the accidents had alcoholic beverages contribute heavily towards causing the accidents. Over the twelve month span, the death rate averaged 2.8 deaths per month, and one death for every 9.9 miles of roadway. In order to have a clear, concise picture of the type and age of victim, as well as the manner and contributing factors of these fatal motor vehicle accidents, the following facts are outlined for you.

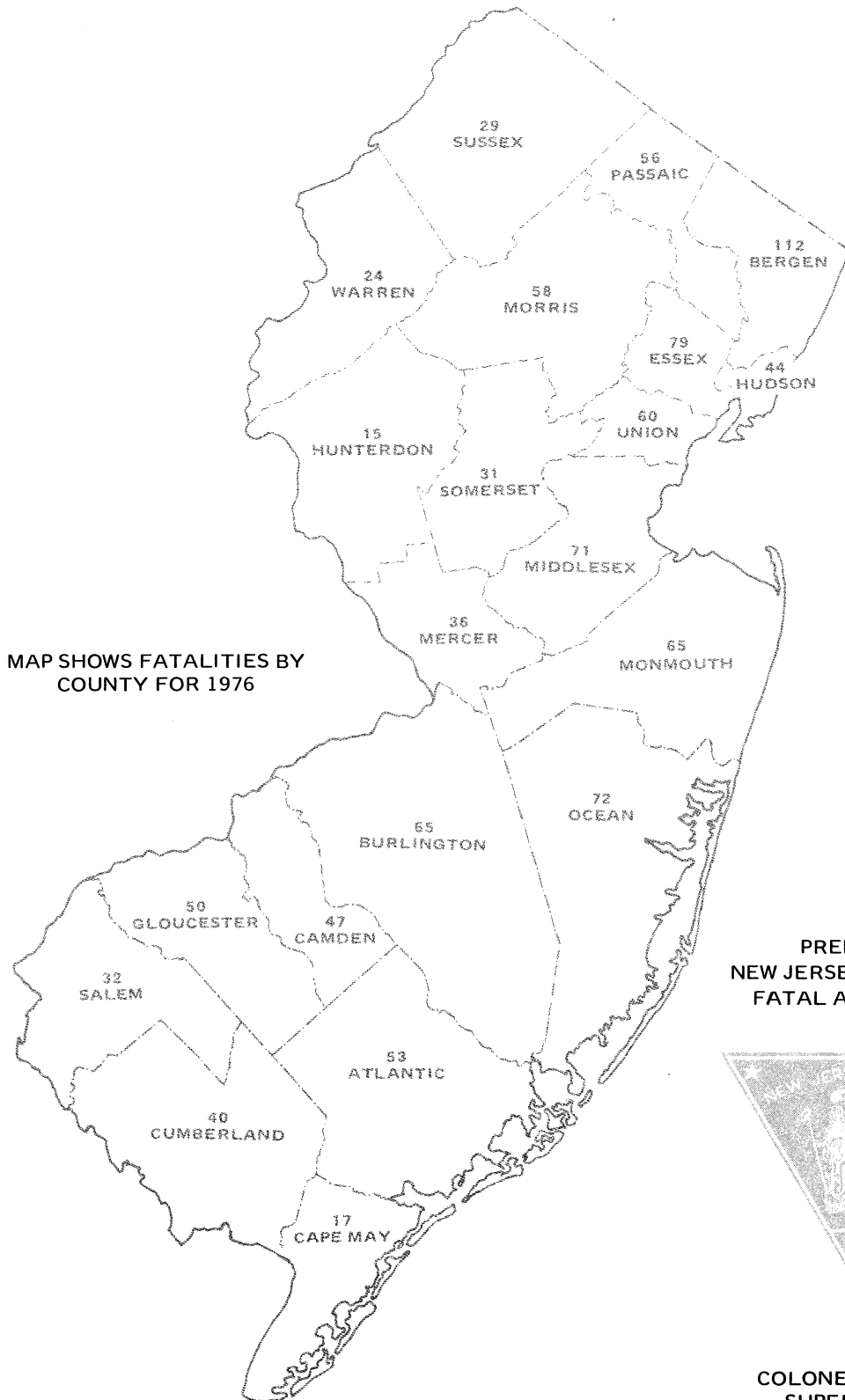
