The New Jersey State Police employs Public Safety Telecommunicators assigned to the following five Communications Centers:

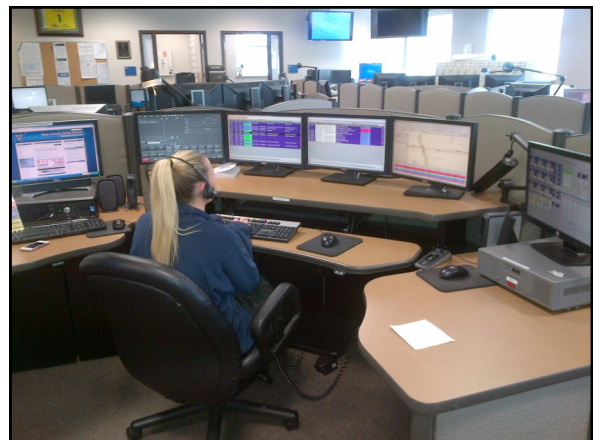
- ▼ **Operational Dispatch Unit—North** **Totowa**
- ▼ **Operational Dispatch Unit—Central** **Hamilton**
- ▼ **Operational Dispatch Unit—South** **Buena Vista**
- ▼ **Operational Dispatch Unit—Turnpike/Parkway** **Woodbridge**
- ▼ **Call Center Unit** **Ewing**

Responsibilities Include, but are not limited to:

- ▼ Dispatching State Police Patrols
- ▼ Processing 9-1-1 Calls
- ▼ Processing State Police Emergency and Non-Emergency Calls for Service
- ▼ In response to medical emergencies is trained in the provision of first aid or CPR instructions to stabilize the medical condition of persons until arrival of professional medical assistance
- ▼ Utilization of the Criminal Justice System

Minimum Qualifications:

- ▼ Ability to read, write, speak and understand English
- ▼ Pass an employment background investigation
- ▼ Ability to multi-task and type onto a computer keyboard while speaking on a telephone or radio
