DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESPONSE TEAM

Become a DVRT volunteer for **your local police department**, in collaboration with **Providence House Domestic Violence Services of Catholic Charities**.

Volunteers receive **free training** (40 hours) where they will learn how to work with the police and provide information, support and referrals to victims at police departments.

Applicants must be:

- 18 years of age or older
- Resident of, or employed in the Burlington County Area
- Valid NJ drivers license and access to transportation
- No criminal history (which is verified by a free background check)
